Scope of Works

This scheme is a refurbishment of the once Daily Mirror’s Headquarters. Restore London works concentrated on the internal cleaning & restoration of the extended spaces taking the building to 150,695 sq ft. of new office space and 9,000 sq. ft of high specification residential space. Restore London controlled cleaning, repairs & refurbishment of the internal brickwork, stonework, mosaic, terrazzo, ceramic tiling & concrete. The concept was to marry the restored old with the contemporary new & with Restore London team multi-skilled input, this was achieved. In particular, the removal of paint from internal concrete columns & ceilings by way of disciplined wet abrasive cleaning was meticulously controlled with deployment of SHE best practice.
